She has already finished reading the pre-course reading and asked for more areas where she can develop to prepare for her Level 3 studies. Outside of school Lora does her own research into computers and coding. In every free time she uses her time wisely to revise/ read. She entered the Young Geographer of the year competition last year entering fantastic independent research into a geographical topic of her choice that was creative, informative and academic.</p> <p>Lora wanted the challenge of sitting the full A level in German whilst still in Year 11 and has prepared independently and thoroughly for all of the components of the exam, including the in-depth study of a novel and a film. This is typical; continuously showing a desire to be challenged intellectually by seeking out opportunities to learn and by asking stimulating questions. As a part of the German A level, she has also undertaken an Independent Research Project for the speaking exam. In French lessons, she asks insightful questions and wants to understand all aspects of the language at the highest level, including grammar and idiomatic expression.</p>
